HOW CAN I JOIN?

WE BEGIN ON 19TH JUNE 2023 AND WILL END ON FEAST OF ST. JOSEPH ON 19TH MARCH 2024.

Through the pledge to undertake Spiritual Adoption, a person commits to praying daily for nine months for the conversion of a father.

- 2. RECITE THE DAILY PRAYER (SEE BELOW)**
- 3. CARRY OUT A PERSONAL UNDERTAKING (OPTIONAL)**

THE DAILY PRAYER

Jesus told Saint Faustina: "The prayer most pleasing to Me is prayer for the conversion of sinners. Know, My daughter, that this prayer is always heard and answered" (Diary, 1397).



Abba Father, I ask that You bless and anoint this father whom I have spiritually adopted with the Blood and Water pouring forth from the Heart of Your Son Jesus. Give him a heart of fire for God, a heart of flesh for neighbor, and a heart of bronze for himself. May he be a wellspring of the joy of living like St. Joseph, a humble servant of the Lord. Amen.
